

PRELIMINARY ANNOUNCEMENT

2nd Biennial Meeting

Philosophy of Science Association

BOSTON—OCTOBER 23–25, 1970

Following up the highly successful first independent meeting (Pittsburgh, October 1968), the Association announces the continuation of the series of its biennial meetings. The meeting place will be the Sheraton-Boston Hotel. Subsequent announcements about local arrangements will be sent to the membership and published in *Philosophy of Science*.

Sessions at these meetings will include some Symposia among invited participants, with symposia topics and participants to be announced later. A number of other sessions will be devoted to submitted papers. Papers from those interested in participating will be considered for inclusion in the program if submitted by March 1, 1970. Inquiries and submitted papers (an original and one carbon copy) should be directed to the Chairman of the Program Committee, Professor Roger C. Buck, Department of History and Philosophy of Science, Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana 47401.

PUBLICATION

It is planned that a substantial portion of the proceedings will be published, soon after the meeting, in a volume of *Boston Studies in the Philosophy of Science*. This publication will be under the joint editorship of Professor Robert S. Cohen and the Program Committee Chairman. Publication has already been arranged and, subject to the usual editorial and publisher's discretion, it is envisioned that the volume will include the symposia and groups of mutually relevant submitted papers.

Symposiasts and authors of submitted papers are asked to bear in mind these publication plans. Participants will receive additional information on publication as the program is developed.
