The Society for American Archaeology announces the establishment of a Distinguished Service Award, to recognize among its members specific accomplishments of extraordinary quality. The Award will be presented at the Annual Business Meeting of the Society to a member whose professional career has resulted in a genuine and lasting contribution to archaeology and, in addition, whose specific accomplishments can be recognized as clearly outstanding.

Recognition can be granted in a wide range of areas relating to archaeology, including, for example, teaching (academic as well as public education), research (theory, method, application of new technology, analysis, etc.), and conservation of archaeological data (curatorial, legal, managerial), as long as two basic criteria are met. First, the contribution must be truly extraordinary (not expected in the normal course of events) and must be recognized widely as such; second, it must be of a positive and lasting quality.

Each recommendation should be supported by a 500-word statement documenting concisely and thoroughly the achievements of the nominee. The deadline for receiving recommendations is October 1, 1979.
