## Getting help in English What to say...

How do you say "	
in English?	

How do you say this word?

### **Common errors**

Use *do* in simple present questions with you.

How **do** you say . . . ? (Not <del>How you say</del> . . . ?)

I'm sorry. I don't understand.

## **Common errors**

Use *don't* or *doesn't* in simple present negative statements. Don't use no.

I don't understand.
(Not I no understand.)

What do you mean?

What does " mean?

### **Common errors**

Use *does* in simple present questions with he, she, it and singular nouns.

What **does** this word **mean**? (Not What means this word?)

I'm sorry. Can you repeat that, please?

Can you say that again, please?

#### **Common errors**

When you ask for help, say *Can you* . . . ? *Can you* repeat that, please? (Not <del>You can repeat that, please?</del>)

Can you explain the activity again, please?

What do we have to do?

### **Common errors**

Don't say me after explain.

Can you explain the activity?

(Not Can you explain me the activity?)

#### **Common errors**

Use **do** or **does** in simple present questions. What **do** you have . . . ? (Not What you have . . . ?)

Do you unde	erstand thi	s sentence?
-------------	-------------	-------------

Yeah. It means "\_\_\_\_\_."

#### **Common errors**

Simple present verbs after he, she, it end in –s. It **means** "\_\_\_\_."
(Not It mean "\_\_\_.")
