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Notes for the teacher

Test 1

Exercise 1 (page 3)

In this exercise, pupils draw a picture for the front of their postcard and then write to their friend on the reverse.

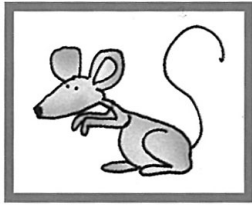
