

Overview of the Changes in the Cambridge Latin Course, 4th Edition

The 4th Edition of the Cambridge Latin Course includes updates and changes to the student book, workbook, teacher's manual, audio program and stage tests. Student book design has been updated, full color is used throughout, and specially commissioned photos have been added. Comprehension questions, *Practicing the Language* and *Word Study* sections have been expanded. Units 3 and 4 include additional *Word Patterns* and *Word Family* sections with expanded work on derivatives. The Omnibus Workbooks are more comprehensive, include additional exercises for all Stage elements and provide practice suitable for the National Latin Exam (e.g. more derivative work, mottoes). The Teacher's Manual is more user-friendly with its larger format including comprehensive teaching notes, suggestions for extension activities, answer keys and translations for the student text and workbook. Overhead transparencies and picture cue cards are now available for Units 1 and 2. Finally, audio CDs, stage tests are available for all levels.

3rd Edition users will find the detailed changes to the 4th edition (Vocabulary Checklists, Culture Notes and About the Language Notes) useful.
