

ERROR CORRECTION

Aim: Give Ss practice correcting written errors in pairs.

Preparation: Make one copy of the worksheet for every two Ss.

Cut the copies in half.

Comment: Use after the Grammar Focus or before the Writing on page 96.

- Give half the class Worksheet A and half the class Worksheet B.
- Explain that six sentences on each worksheet have grammar mistakes. Ss write *C* if the sentence is correct and *NC* if it is not correct.
- Ss complete this part of the task individually.
- Put Ss in pairs. One has Worksheet A and one has Worksheet B. They compare sentences and decide which one is correct. (For each sentence, one S has the correct sentence.)
- Go over answers with the class.
