A journal of the type of *Philosophy of Science* must rely on the ordering of reprints by authors for a significant part of its income. It is with great regret, therefore, that we withdraw the policy of furnishing twenty-five reprints gratis, and replace it with the requirement that authors must order 100 reprints at a cost of \$1.00 per printed page. They may get additional reprints at a lower price which will be indicated on special order slips sent with proof. The increased cost to an author who would normally order 100 reprints is small.

The new regulation comes into effect with the next issue, July, 1939.
