# Editorial

This issue of ReCALL is the first which is published by the CTI Centre for Modern Languages in association with EUROCALL. During 1994, an international panel of readers will be appointed and, from 1995, ReCALL will be a fully-refereed and re-designed journal. It continues to be supplied free of charge to libraries in UK higher education institutions and is also available to EUROCALL subscribers. The new ReCALL Newsletter, which replaces the much smaller ReCALL\NewsSheet is published three times a year and distributed free of charge to higher education Modern Languages lecturers. The first issue was distributed in February 1994, and is also available electronically via the Hull University Gopher system (see page 60).

The continued existence of *ReCALL* publications has, hitherto, been somewhat precarious, given that in 1989 the CTI Centres were initially funded for a three-year period, and after the end of that period received only short-term funding. Following a recent review of CTI Centres, the Higher Education Funding Councils have now accepted the Review Group's recommendation that CTI Centres should continue for at least a further five years. This excellent news, combined with our association with EUROCALL, means that we can look forward to enhancing our activities with real confidence.

The articles in *ReCALL* Vol. 6 No. 1 offer a mixture of topics appealing to the very wide range of interests of our readers. Researchers, developers, practitioners and managers involved in learning technology for languages will all find something useful. In addition, thanks to the efforts of Jenny Parsons and our panel of reviewers, we have an extensive selection of new software reviews.
