The Canadian Society for History and Philosophy of Mathematics, which founded its historical journal *Historia Mathematica* in 1974, announces the publication of Series Three of *Philosophia Mathematica* as its philosophical journal. *Philosophia Mathematica* is the only journal devoted specifically to philosophy of mathematics, its learning (by research or instruction) and its application. It was founded in 1964 and edited until early 1992 through Series One and Two by J. Fang. The journal has been completely reorganized, with a new active Editorial Board, and will be published for the Society semi-annually from Spring 1993 by the University of Toronto Press.

- Discussions of philosophical issues relating to logic and the logical structure of language, such as conventionalism in logic, ontic commitment, logical or semantic paradoxes, the logic of hypotheses and of pre-suppositions, constructivism, and extensionality.
- Philosophical work relating to specific sciences (such as linguistics, history of logic, or physics), with an emphasis on foundational problems, and making use of logical theory. Some instances of recent work of this kind are the treatments of universal grammar, pragmatics, conceptions of possibility, theories and mathematical truth in the history of philosophy, formalization of scientific theories, or logical structure in quantum mechanics.

The Journal of Philosophical Logic is published under the auspices of the Association for Symbolic Logic.
