COURS DE BRONCHO-OESOPHAGOSCOPIE

Sur l'invitation du Docteur J. M. Le Mée, Chef de Service d'Oto-Rhino-Laryngologie à l'Hopital Necker-Enfants Malades, et du Docteur Braine, Chirurgien des Hopitaux de Paris, Directeur de l'Ecole d'Anatomie des Hopitaux, le Docteur Chevalier Lawrence Jackson, Professeur de Clinique de Broncho Oesophagoscopie à Temple University de Philadelphie, avec la collaboration de M.M. Fernand Eeman, de Gand ; Da Costa Quinta, de Lisbonne ; J. Vialle, de Nice et A. Soulas, de Paris, anciens Assistants des Cliniques Bronchoscopiques de Philadelphie, commencera le 3 Juillet, 1939, un Cours à la fois théorique et pratique de Bronchologie et l'Oesophagologie.

Ce Cours sera fait en français, en anglais, en portugais et en espagnol ; il durera 10 journées et se terminera le 13 Juillet au soir.

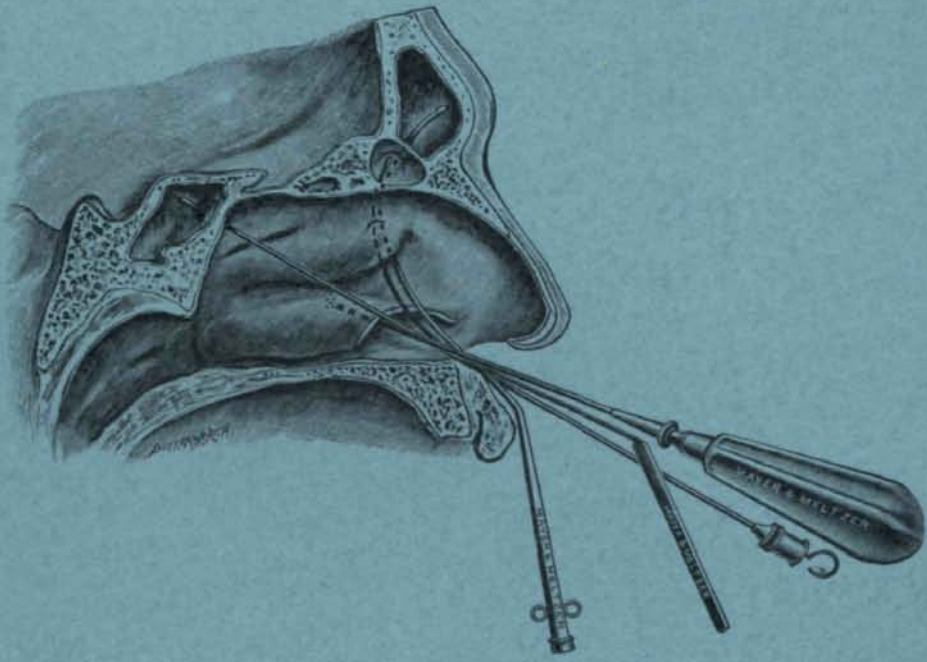

CENTRAL LONDON THROAT, NOSE AND EAR HOSPITAL.

The Post-Graduation School of the Central London Throat, Nose and Ear Hospital has entirely revised its syllabus so as to provide two complete five months' courses each year. In addition to daily clinical teaching with systematic lecture-demonstrations, the courses include instruction in the specialized anatomy and physiology with facilities for dissection of the head, neck and thorax, pathology and bacteriology, radiology, x-ray and radio-therapy, endoscopy, speech therapy, etc. The School has invited representative members of the Specialty other than those on the Staff of the Hospital and School to lecture during the Courses and in addition, visits with demonstrations have been arranged to the special departments of some of the Undergraduate Hospitals.
