ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER, 1956

We have completed the audit of the Books and Accounts of the Society for the year ended 31st December, 1956, and report thereon as follows.

GENERAL PURPOSES ACCOUNT

The balance on this account at the end of the year was £6,345 13s. 7d. after transferring £140 from the Life Membership Fund in respect of subscriptions of deceased Life Members and deducting £475 2s. 1d. being the excess of Expenditure over Income on the year's working.

The figure of £475 2s. 1d. referred to above compares with an excess of income over expenditure of £268 17s. in respect of the previous year. A sum of £150 has been transferred to the Secretary's Travelling Expenses Account in accordance with the Minutes of the Society and there is a balance at the end of the year on this account of £235 13s.

During the year the following amounts were received: Donations, £243 0s. 8d., and Legacies, £138 19s. 5d.; and these have been transferred to the General Reserve Fund. In the previous year Donations amounting to £243 8s. 6d. were transferred to the General Reserve Fund, while Legacies amounting to £202 2s. 11d. formed part of the surplus of £268 17s. referred to above.

GENERAL RESERVE FUND

A further sum of £382 0s. 1d. has been placed to reserve which represents the amount of the Donations and Legacies received during the year. The balance on the Fund at 31st December, 1956, was £4,202 8s. 11d.

LIFE MEMBERSHIP FUND

The balance standing to the credit of the Fund is now £3,080. This is after crediting £355 in respect of Life Membership subscriptions received during the year and transferring £140 to the General Purposes Account which represents the value of subscriptions of those Life Members who died during the year.

INVESTMENTS

The total investments at 31st December, 1956, at cost amounted to £13,493 11s. and the Market Value at that date was £12,296 0s. 5d., showing a net depreciation of £1,197 10s. 7d.

Surplus

The surplus of Assets over Liabilities at the end of the year amounted to £13,628 2s. 6d. as compared with £13,372 10s. 11d. at the end of the previous year.
