Peterson elucidates the underlying conceptual scheme of Wittgenstein's *Tractatus* and shows that, when this scheme is identified and emphasized, much of the work's obscurity dissolves; the reader is able to understand Wittgenstein's diverse terminology, the purpose and context of his individual remarks, and the overall coherence of *Tractatus*. Peterson also clarifies Wittgenstein's discussion of the mystical, and applies his ideas about representation and logic to the new field of cognitive science. \$40.00
