

# LIBRARIANS LARR SUBSCRIBERS

For the convenience of LASA members who automatically receive LARR as part of their prerogatives, the Editorial Committee has approved LARR's changing from its academic-year cycle (Fall, Spring and Summer) to a calendar-year cycle (Spring, Summer and Fall). To do this we are numbering the next issue of LARR, normally our Volume IV, number 1, as Vol. III, no. 4.

Those whose subscriptions began with III:1, III:2 or III:3 should renew with III:4, IV:1 or IV:2 respectively. Beginning with Vol. IV, no. 1 (Spring, 1969), the triannual cycle will be resumed but on a calendar-year basis.

LASA members, in good standing of course, will receive Vol. III:4 and upon renewal of membership dues for 1969 will receive IV:1, 2 and 3 in that year.

We hope you will bear with us for this second inconvenient LARR-LASA transition, which (as nearly as we can predict) will be the last.
