Volume 1 contains a bibliography of symbolic logic for the period 1666–1935; a list of additions and corrections to this bibliography, together with indexes to the whole, will appear in an early number. A complete current bibliography of the literature of symbolic logic from January 1, 1936, including both books and articles, is provided by prompt publication of critical reviews (indexed biennially).

Subscription to the Journal is \$3.00 annually. Single numbers of the current volume are \$1.00 each. Completed volumes (four numbers) will be sold at \$4.00. Single copies of the bibliographical number, Volume 1 Number 4, will be sold at \$1.50 (rag paper edition, \$2.00). Other single numbers are \$1.25.

Offprints of the list of additions, corrections, and indexes to the bibliography will be placed on sale later. These may be bound with Volume 1 Number 4 to form a complete bibliography of symbolic logic to the end of the year 1935.
