## EDITORIAL COMMENT

We will keep up to four pages of commentary in each issue to ensure flexibility and rapid publication, but the format within these pages will be formulated from your responses, perhaps to include two or more short articles or one large one.

Contributions will be refereed by an appropriate Board Member and we reserve the right to return any contribution unsuitable for publication, and to select only the most appropriate for contemporary debate.

We look forward to your response and hope that you, as readers, can generate four interesting and thought-provoking pages to introduce each issue of the Bulletin.
