Regional Reports

Colloquium on Materials Structure Characterization Techniques. Jaroslav Fiala, Central Research Institute, SKODA, 316 Plzen, Czech Republic

Colloquium "Materials Structure Characterization Techniques," organized by the Czech and Slovak Crystallographic Association (CSCA) were held 24–28 June 1996 at Stare Hamry, Czech Republic.

The contributions were classified into four categories: crystallography in materials science and mineralogy; crystallography in chemistry and biology; crystallography in physics; and surfaces and thin layers. In all, 32 oral contributions and 24 posters were presented at the colloquium of which namely "Principles of Some Modern Deconvolution Methods" (M. Cernansky), "Diffraction Tensometric Characterization of Non-Conventional Methods Separation" (N. Ganev and I. Kraus), "Applications of X-ray Diffraction in Medicine" (D. Krausova), "X-ray Study of Chemical Reaction" (L. Benes et al.), "X-ray Diffraction Study of Silver Films Deposited by R. F. Reactive Sputtering" (P. Tutta, Q. Jackuliak et al.), "Notes to the Methods and Interpretation of Phase and Structure Analysis of Hydroxylapatite" (A. Buchal), "X-ray Diffraction Profile Analysis for Polymer Mixtures" (M. Hork, J. Baldrian) were of direct concern of

powder diffraction. In addition to this, a number of other contributions aroused the interest of attendees, like "Possibilities of Phase Analysis at the Interpretation of Electron Diffraction Patterns' (Z. Novy), "Possibilities of Modern Transmission Microscopy" (A. Orlova), "LEED in Surface Crystallography" (I. Barto), "Use of Ion Back Scattering for Study of Crystal and Real Structure of Materials" (D. Machajdik), "Application of NMR Spectroscopy for Study of 3D-Structure of Biopolymers" (V. Sklenar) and "X-ray Crystallography in Czech Pharmaceutical Industry' (B. Kratochvil). Proceedings of the colloquium, edited by P. Kuel, were published as two separate issues of the third volume of the journal "Materials Structure in Chemistry, Biology, Physics and Technology" (280 pp. together) and delivered to the attendees upon registration. Scientific instruments exhibition, annual meeting of CSCA members, a trip to the surrounding Beskydy mountains, and a farewell party completed the program which was enjoyed by some 80 participants (mostly from the Czech and Slovak Republics) who expressed their satisfaction to both the Organizing Committee (chaired by D. Krausova and J. Kamenicek) and the Program Committee (chaired by J. Hajek and R. Kuzel).
