# PHILOSOPHY OF SCIENCE

Manuscript should be submitted in duplicate to any of the editors whose addresses appear on the inside front cover. Stamps for return of manuscript should be included. All reference material should be listed alphabetically at the end, and referred to by numbers. Footnotes should be numbered consecutively. Manuscripts should include headings for the sections of the paper which will subsequently be printed in bold face with Arabic numerals. *Manuscripts should not exceed 30 typewritten pages.* An abstract of approximately 100 words should accompany each manuscript; such abstracts will be submitted to other journals upon acceptance of the manuscript.

Contributors of articles to the journal will receive, gratis, one hundred reprints. Authors desiring more, should order them from the Managing Editor at the time they receive galleys.

Publications intended for review should be sent to Dr. J. SAYER MINAS Case Institute of Technology, Cleveland, Ohio.

PHILOSOPHY OF SCIENCE is published quarterly, appearing January, April, July and October.
