

Dr. Gregory Cairncross assumes Headship, Department of Clinical Neurosciences, University of Calgary



Dr. J. Gregory Cairncross assumed the Headship of the Department of Clinical Neurosciences, University of Calgary and the Calgary Health Region on October 1, 2002.

He also holds a new appointment as the Alberta Cancer Foundation Chair in Brain Tumour Research. Dr. Cairncross completed his training in Neurology at the New York Hospital-Cornell and subsequently in Neuro-oncology at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center. As a pioneer and international leader in the field of Neuro-oncology, his discoveries have highlighted the biology of chemosensitive gliomas. His most recent position was as Head of the Department of Oncology, University of Western Ontario and CEO of the London Regional Cancer Center in London Ontario. His new colleagues in Neurosciences and Oncology welcome his arrival in Calgary.
