Konta J. (Editor). Ninth Conference on Clay Mineralogy and Petrology in Zvolen, August 31-September 3, 1982. Charles University Press, Albertov 6, Prague 2, Czechoslovakia, 1984. 240 pp. Price 38 Kčs.

This well-produced proceedings volume contains 30 papers of which 27 are in English and three in German. The papers, generally 5–8 pp. in length, cover a range of topics, with emphasis on X-ray structural determinations, smectite properties, and clay mineral alteration products of igneous rocks.
