Even before the group's formal establishment a number of symposia on these same topics had been organized.



The group consists of approximately 12 members, drawn from a variety of disciplines and nominated for a three-year period. The group has developed into one of the most active and dynamic groups within the Academia, especially through the preparation and organization, since 2005, of a series of international symposia that address important and topical issues and problems of higher education. These are summarized below. Moreover, the outcomes of the in-depth and critical analyses of these issues during the conferences have resulted in the publication of Proceedings. Through the dissemination of these Proceedings, we have made a contribution to the further discussion and reflection about the topics in academic circles, and by doing so potentially to the future development and shaping of higher education in Europe.

Occasionally, the conferences have also led to a formal statement about an issue that, after approval by the Board of Trustees, is published as an official standpoint of the Academia Europaea.

Through these activities, the HERCulES Expert Group provides the AE with a powerful vehicle for promoting the international visibility of the Academia Europaea, and an important lever for the positioning of the Academia in the European higher education space.
