LEADERSHIP FOR PREVENTION IN HEALTH CARE REFORM

PREVENTION 93 will bring together leaders and experts from governmental agencies, foundations, managed care and other clinical settings, insurance, industry and academia to explore the scientific advances that have moved prevention to the forefront of health care issues and corporate policy and to examine the overall role of prevention in health care reform.

Participants will examine the roles and responsibilities of public health, organized medicine, the private sector and individuals in the proposed health care systems. Major areas of consideration will be access and delivery, the relationship between prevention and primary care, the inclusion of public health and clinical preventive services and the costs - human and economic - of including or excluding prevention strategies in health care reform. The manner in which preventionists are trained will also be explored to determine how to adapt the training of preventive medicine specialists to the evolving system and how to integrate prevention into the training of generalist physicians and other health professionals.


