CONGRÈS FRANÇAIS D'OTO LARYNGOLOGIE.

The twenty-ninth Annual Congress of the Società Italiana di Laryngologia, Otologia e Rinologia will be held from September 9th-12th at Bolzano. He was Professor of Oto-laryngology at the University of Pennsylvania; an active member on the staff of the Annals of Otology and of the Archives of Oto-laryngology.


He was not only a Fellow, but also a Vice-President of that exclusive body—The American Laryngological Association—and his turn for President would have come this year.
