## **Book Reviews**

CLINICAL NEUROLOGYOFTHE OLDER ADULT, 2002. Editors: Joseph I. Sirven, Barabar L. Malamut. Published by Lippincott Williams & Wilkins. 558 pages. C\$103.00 approx.

There is long-standing interest in the interface between neurology and geriatrics. In the 19th century J.M. Charcot gave a series of clinical lectures on the diseases of old age. Neurological diseases commonly bedevil older patients. A concise yet comprehensive overview of geriatric neurology would be an appreciated addition to the medical literature. Sirven and Malamut try to fill this niche with indifferent results.

The book aims to be a practical guide to the neurological illnesses of older patients. It has 64 contributors. Having such a number of authors leads to a disjointed writing style and inconsistencies in the quality of chapters. Many of the contributors are quite junior (six are residents or fellows). Good textbooks allow you to benefit from the insight of experienced clinicians. They can filter data, determine what should inform clinical practice, and ultimately refine it to the gist.
