### *Preliminary Test—September 1984*

### *AUTP Postgraduate Training in Behavioural Psychotherapy*

The Association of University Teachers of Psychiatry with the Institute of Psychiatry runs an annual course in behavioural psychotherapy mainly intended for consultants and senior registrars and those of equivalent status, including specialist psychotherapists. The forthcoming course will be mainly for Psychiatric Tutors of the Royal College of Psychiatrists, but a limited number of other places may be available.

The course will begin with a two-day workshop on 26 and 27 September 1985. This will include the following components: theoretical background, demonstration of treatments and participant practice in small groups. After the workshop participants will be asked to undertake behavioural

treatment of their own patients in their own centres, and later also to supervise other trainees. Participants will be supervised in small groups at monthly intervals in half-day sessions over the following academic year.

The course is organized on lines which qualify for local funding assistance under Study Leave Regulations of the BPFM. Cost of the combined workshop and monthly supervision over the following academic year is £245.
