Recent Applications published by the International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature in the *Bulletin of Zoological Nomenclature* (vol. 43, part 1, 9 April 1986) included the following:

Tylocidaris Pomel, 1883 (Echinoidea, Cidaroidea): proposed designation of Cidaris clavigera Mantell, 1822, as type species.

Ammonites perarmatus J. Sowerby, 1822 (Cephalopoda, Ammonoidea): proposed exemption from the Principle of Homonymy.

Type species of the genus Calymene Brongniart (Trilobita) in Brongniart and Desmarest, 1822, and proposed suppression of the name tuberculatus Brünnich, 1781.

Recent Opinions published in the same issue of the Bulletin included the following:

Opinion 1371 (p. 19)—Pachycephalosaurus Brown and Schlaikjer, 1943, and Troodon wyomingensis Gilmore, 1931 (Reptilia, Dinosauria): conserved.
