TEMPORAL BONE SURGICAL DISSECTION COURSE

THE Ear Research Institute announces a two-week Temporal Bone Surgical Dissection Course demonstrating the multiple approaches to the structures of the temporal bone as currently used by members of the Otologic Medical Group Inc.

The course members will be divided each day to observe surgery by new color television that will correlate with the dissections of the day done in the new Dissection Laboratory. Color video tapes of any or all surgery observed by the student will be available. Evenings will be devoted to lectures and motion picture demonstrations.

The instructors will dissect in the temporal bone laboratory over closed circuit television and each student will be supervised at the various procedures and approaches that are performed.

Twenty board-certified or board-eligible otolaryngologists and residents will be accepted in each course. Courses will be presented 14-26 March, 16-28 May, 1-13 August, 10-22 October, 1976. The tuition fee for otolaryngologists is \$1,200 and for residents \$900 in United States currency. Applications of residents must be accompanied by a letter from their Chief of Service.
