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- 1. The author should keep a complete copy of the submitted article; the Society will not accept responsibility for any loss. Two copies of the typescript should be submitted.
- 2. Each typescript should include: (i) an abstract of not more than 150 words, preferably containing no formulae, and certainly containing no complicated formulae and no references, (ii) a 1980 Mathematics subject classification (Amer. Math. Soc.); the classification scheme is described in Mathematical Reviews, Index to Volume 56 (1978), (iii) a shortened title (which may be the title itself).
