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The Daniel & Nina Carasso's Prize committee announces the launch of the second Premio Daniel Carasso. The prize aims to award an international renowned research scientist who, through cross-disciplinary researches, has innovative and realistic approaches in order to develop "sustainable food and diets for long-term human health". The award winner receives an amount of € 100,000 and is backed by the Daniel & Nina Carasso Foundation.

Submissions will last three months from 1st April to 30 June 2014. The Prize committee will meet in the fall 2014 to select a list of finalists; the Jury will meet during the 1st semester 2015 to select the award winner of the Second Premio Daniel Carasso.

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
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
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
