THE F. H. BRADLEY COLLOQUIUM

'Appearance & Reality 1893 - 1993'

Merton College, Oxford, 2nd - 5th April 1993

A CALL FOR PAPERS

An international conference to commemorate the centenary of the publication of Bradley's *Appearance & Reality* will be held from the 2nd - 5th April 1993, at Merton College, Oxford. Bradley was a Fellow of Merton and lived in the College from 1870 until his death in 1924.

The Colloquium is being sponsored by the *Mind* Association, in whose journal, *Mind*, much of Bradley's work was originally published.

The aim of the Colloquium is not primarily historical. It is intended to bring together philosophers working mainly within the areas of metaphysics, epistemology, and philosophical logic who have found themes in Appearance & Reality relevant in their own work and to contemporary discussion within those areas.

There will be a number of plenary sessions from invited speakers with respondents. In addition there will be a series of discussion sessions based on contributed papers. These papers should be produced on A4 paper, be double spaced in 'letter quality' type, and be not more than 12 sides in length.

A collection of papers, subject to editorial approval after presentation, will be published by Oxford University Press in the *Mind* Association Occasional Volume Series. Papers will be accepted for the Colloquium only on condition that they have not been published elsewhere and they will, if required, be made available for publication in this volume.
