





Journal of the Gilded Age and Progressive Era Instructions for access to online edition at the History Cooperative <www.historycooperative.org>

1. For Institutional Subscribers

If you are connecting from an institution that currently subscribes to the *Journal of the Gilded Age and Progressive Era*, you will automatically receive access to full online content. This is enabled through the use of institutional IP number ranges and does not require your personal login. If your institution subscribes to the paper journal but you find that you cannot access the full-text online version from your campus, please ask your librarian to fill out our Online IP Registration Form, <<http://www.historians.org/HistoryCoop/>>, which will add your institutional IP numbers to our control system. 2. For Individual Members

If you are not connecting through a subscriber institution, but you are an individual subscriber to the journal, you can set up a personal account to access the entire run of the *Journal of the Gilded Age and Progressive Era* online. Simply register by using your subscription ID number, as shown on your journal mailing label. On the History Cooperative home page, click on the bottom right where it says, “How to access” or “Follow this link.” Then follow the instructions. The subscription ID number is only needed the first time you access the online edition as a way to authenticate the visitor. During your first login or any time thereafter, you can set up a personal login and password for future access. If you already have an account, you can go to the login screen at <<http://www.historycooperative.org/login.html>>. Current subscribers

Step 1. To activate membership in the SHGAPE renewal system:

1. If you've already received an email from SHGAPE's Membership Secretary Skip Hyser regarding our online system, you should proceed to Step 2. If you haven't yet received such a message, please send an email to Kalani Craig, SHGAPE's Subscription Manager, at craigkl@indiana.edu from the email address you'd like to use as your SHGAPE contact.
2. You'll receive an email with your member ID. Your member ID is the 5-digit number printed on the label of any mail you receive from SHGAPE. Once you've received this message, you can use your email address and member ID number to log in to the online renewal system.

Step 2. Renewing your membership in the SHGAPE online system:

1. Go to www.jgape.org, click on "Subscriptions" and then "Renew" and use your email address and your member ID to log in.
2. Select "Renew" from the drop-down menu and press "Go."
3. Update your contact information, select your renewal options and enter your bank account information.
4. Press "Renew" to complete the process.

New subscribers

1. Go to www.jgape.org, click on "Subscriptions" and then click "To join SHGAPE, click here."
2. Fill in your contact information, select your membership options and enter your bank account information.
3. Press "Join" to complete the process.

PLEASE NOTE: Your membership or renewal will be personally verified by a SHGAPE administrator before your payment is processed, so it may take a few days for your transaction to show in your bank account.
