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Policy Phonology is concerned with all aspects of phonology and related disciplines. Each volume contains two issues, published in April and October. From time to time, one of the issues will be devoted to one or more themes. The editors encourage the submission of papers on proposed themes as well as on other topics relevant to the interests of Phonology. In addition, they welcome offers to act as guest editor for particular themes. The normal language of publication is English. Contributors intending to submit a manuscript in another language should first contact the editors.

Future volumes

Volume 10 number 2 (1993) will be partly devoted to papers on Sign language phonology (Guest editor: Wendy Sandler). Volume 11 (1994) will be non-thematic.
