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The Survey of Socio-economic Factors Related to Rate of Child Abuse in the Family

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Introduction:

The main aim of the study is The Survey of Socio-economic Factors Related to Rate of child Abuse in the Family of Karaj Hesarak province of Iran.

Method: This research has followed a survey method using questionnaires. The participant of this study was families living in Karaj Hesarak. Data were collected by a structured questionnaire from 400 Family who were systematic-randomly selected.

Results: According to result, a significant correlation was found between a age, sexuality, income, level of education, family size, Social capital, Mental health and religious orientation to Rate of child Abuse in the Family. The results of regression equation showed that, factors including: Mental health, family size, Social capital, income and religious orientation influence on child Abuse in the Family.

These factors explain 57 percent of the variation changes in the dependent variable. According to the model path analysis, among these variables mental health has a highest impact on the dependent variable.
