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CDC Funds Surveillance Programs

A cooperative agreement between CDC and selected local agencies was initiated in September 1995 to support 10 Epidemiology and Laboratory Surveillance and Response Programs. The programs are funded from resources allocated

to CDC's National Center for Infectious Disease for 1995 to begin implementation of the emerging infectious disease plan. This program will help state and local health agencies to maintain and strengthen public health surveillance and response for infectious diseases.

Thirty-seven applications were approved for funding, and an objec-

tive review panel recommended that \$1,960,000 be awarded to the top 10 scoring applicants: Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Kansas, Los Angeles County, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York City, Washington, and West Virginia.

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
