

The British Aerospace BAe Series 800 made its first flight on 26th May. This is the most radically improved version of the 125 to date, the principal changes being a new and powerful engine, the Garrett TFE-731-5, a wider span wing, reshaped rear fuselage, increased fin area, new flight deck and curved windscreen and a redesigned instrument layout incorporating Collins EFIS (Electronic Flight Instrument System) providing five CRTs. Orders have been received from two UK customers. The aircraft in the picture is in BAe livery.
