# The 5th Jerusalem Symposium

An International Symposium on 'The Conformation of Biological Molecules and Polymers', sponsored jointly by the Hebrew University, Jerusalem and the Institut de Biologie Physico-Chimique (Fondation Edmond de Rothschild), Paris will be held, under the auspices of the Israel Academy of Sciences and Humanities, in Jerusalem, Israel, from 3 to 7 April 1972.

The aim of this meeting will be the discussion of the present status of our knowledge about the chemical, physico-chemical and biological aspects of the problem. A particular emphasis will be laid on theoretical computations in relation to experimental data obtained with modern techniques.
