

Introduction

The first part of this issue (pp. 5-15) contains a chronologically arranged table of contents of *Itinerario* and its predecessor, the *Newsletter of the Centre for the History of European Expansion*. The Centre began publication of the *Newsletter* in 1975; after two years *Itinerario* appeared, which has gradually developed into a full-fledged scholarly journal in the field of overseas studies. It covers a wide range of themes, which can be seen from the table of contents in the next pages: articles on many topics, interviews, conference reports, research notes, and book reviews.

The second part of this issue consists of a subject index (pp. 17-51) and an authors index (pp. 53-64) to five volumes of the Current Annotated Bibliography of Dutch Expansion Studies (CABDES), the bibliography which usually appears as issue 3/4 of each volume of Itinerario. This cumulative index forms the conclusion of the second series of five annual instalments, sc. the issues 1982 up to and including 1986. The first series of five was concluded with a cumulative index like this one, published in the issue 1981, 3/4. It is hoped that this cumulative index will enhance the usefulness of the bibliographies. On p. 16 you find a note to the users. Beginning with the issue 1988 3/4, every new instalment of the bibliography will include its own subject index in addition to the authors index.
