#### Abstract

The object of this series is to supply those who have passed the preliminary stage with Latin narrative which can be easily read. Care has therefore been taken to select interesting stories, and to simplify the text where it has secmed too difficult.

A full vocabulary and historical appendix are included in each volume, but there are no notes. It has been thought best to let the master decide the amount of help in translation which the class ought to receive.

Many pupils have to bid good-bye to Latin at such an early age th it they carry away little or no knowledge of the language or of the race which used it. It is hoped that those who read this series will, at any rate, learn tomething of the glories of Rome, and of the deeds, lives, and ideals of some of its famous men.

For those who intend further to pursue the study of the language, the series endeavours to satisfy the claims of good scholarship by providing a set of exercises designed to test their knowledge of accidence, syntax, and composition. This portion of the book is interleaved, as the authors are of opinion that it is a good thing for the beginner to make his own record of progress, and to keep it under the same cover as the book he has read.

Teachers are recommended to read the preliminary note as to the method of using the exercises; furthermore, it is suggested that every alternate one should be done at the first reading, the remainder being reserved for revision purposes. - Copies cail be obtained witboat the interleaving, if preferred.
