for orchestra

2 flutes (2nd doubling piccolo), 2 oboes (2nd doubling cor anglais), 2 clarinets (2nd doubling bass clarinet), 2 bassoons (2nd doubling contrabassoon), 4 horns, 4 trumpets, 2 trombones, 2 tubas, timpani, percussion, harp and strings

First performance on 20th April 1965 at the Royal Festival Hall by the London Philharmonic Orchestra conducted by John Pritchard

Shakespeare music

for chamber ensemble

Alto flute (doubling piccolo), oboe, clarinet, bass clarinet, bassoon (doubling contrabassoon), horn, trombone, percussion, guitar, viola and double bass

First performed on 8th December 1964 at a BBC Invitation Concert by the Portia Wind Ensemble conducted by John Carewe

for soprano, alto, tenor, bass, double chorus and instruments

First group: 2 violins, viola, violoncello and double bass (with soloists) Second group: 2 trumpets, 2 trombones and chamber organ I (with choir I) Third group: flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, contrabassoon and chamber organ II (with choir II)

First performance on 1st March 1965 at a St. Pancras Festival Concert by the Ambrosian Singers and the English Chamber Orchestra conducted by Norman Del Mar
