BARBARA DOCHERTY is an editor and writer; an extended version of her article will appear in the forthcoming Contemporary Music Review symposium on voice and text.

STEPHEN MONTAGUE, the new Chairman of the Electro-Acoustic Music Association of Great Britain (EMAS), is a freelance composer based in London. His Piano Concerto, commissioned by the Almeida Festival, was premièred there by Yvar Mikashoff in June. He is currently composing a work to a commission from the New Music America Festival for the Relâche Ensemble.
