

#### AIMS AND SCOPE

Linguistic pragmatics has been able to formulate a number of questions that are essential to our understanding of language as humans' main instrument of "natural" and "societal" interaction. By providing a possible theoretical foundation for the study of linguistic practice, linguistic pragmatics has helped to increase our knowledge of human interaction. The JOURNAL OF PRAGMATICS identifies with the above scope and aims of pragmatics. In addition, the journal will attempt to narrow the distance between such fields as sociolinguistics, psycholinguistics, computational linguistics (including the information sciences, artificial intelligence research and, in general, the theory and practice of machine-human interaction), applied linguistics (including the theory and practice of language teaching and learning), psychiatry (including the study of schizophrenic speech). The journal will also endeavour to cover the "shady" areas between these fields and between linguistics and the neighboring disciplines. The JOURNAL OF PRAGMATICS welcomes both those contributions originating in linguistics proper and those taking neighboring, related fields as their point of
