but rather to political influences. The latter thesis he elaborates in his own contribution about problems and perspectives of workers' management. Other contributions are devoted to, *inter alia*, the role of bureaucracy (L. Tadić), the attitude of the Yugoslav Communist League (V. Cvjetičanin) and the crisis of Socialism (P. Vranicki). J. Županov deals with the interesting problem of the relations between different concerns in one branch of industry.
