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The Mediterranean Archaeological Trust, set up in 1959 for the promotion of the study of archaeology, invites applications for grants, made on a competitive basis, for expenses in 2015–16, in the preparation for final **publication** of material from archaeological **excavation or fieldwork** in the Mediterranean world, **excluding** subventions to publishers or publication of material not from a specific excavation, or in symposia. Within the terms of the Trust, priority may be given to publication of Bronze Age sites. Grants for any amount, however small, will be considered, provided they expedite **publication**. The grants do not normally exceed £2000.

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Submissions are invited in the following categories: Research and Method (each max. 5000 words), and Debate (max. 3000 words). Word limits include all text, tables, references and figure captions.

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As part of the submission process authors will be required to confirm that the substance of the content presented has not been published previously and is not currently being considered for publication elsewhere.

All papers are published in English, and we therefore prefer to receive submissions in English. If submitting in English is absolutely not possible, we may be able to consider submissions in other languages. In this case please contact the Editor (editor@antiquity.ac.uk) for advice before submitting your paper.

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
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
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
