## INSTITUTE OF SOUND AND VIBRATION RESEARCH UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHAMPTON

1980 OCCUPATIONAL DEAFNESS COURSE, 7 TO 9 MAY

THIS course is designed primarily for otolaryngologists, but is suitable also for other medical and scientific personnel concerned with the investigation and assessment of occupational deafness.

The programme covers the differential diagnosis of noise-induced hearing loss and the medico-legal aspects of occupational deafness, but also includes lectures on the principles and implementation of industrial hearing conservation schemes. The basic physics of noise and its quantitative relationship with hearing loss is explained and there is discussion of the rehabilitation of patients with occupational deafness.

A number of practical sessions accompany the lectures, for demonstration of, and experience with, techniques for measurement and investigation of hearing loss, and measurement of noise.

The course is recognised by the Council for Postgraduate Medical Education in England and Wales under its advanced postgraduate training scheme.
