CALL FOR PAPERS

1974 Western Finance Association Meetings
June 9-11, 1974
Las Vegas, Nevada

The Annual Meetings of the Western Finance Association will be held in conjunction with the Western Economic Association on June 9-11 at the Sahara Hotel in Las Vegas, Nevada. Members and friends of the Association are invited to submit papers for possible presentation at the Meetings. The papers should be in four general areas:

1. Investments
2. Corporate Finance
3. Financial Institutions and Monetary Policy
4. Consumer, Real Estate, and International Finance and Risk Management

Twelve copies of a five-page summary of the paper, stating the problem, method, data, and implications of the findings, should be sent to the Chairman of the Program Committee by *October 15, 1973*. The papers will be reviewed by the Program Committee. The program will attempt to emphasize participation by junior and newer members of the profession. *Abstracts* of the papers selected will be published in the Proceedings issue of the *Journal of Financial and Quantitative Analysis*.

6. Last year author presented a paper at the WFA
7. Would author serve as a discussant if paper is not selected?

Financing Policy
