Arising out of a number of the sessions, special issues of *Mineralogical Magazine* and *The Canadian Mineralogist* are planned. Papers will also be published in *American Mineralogist* and in the *European Journal of Mineralogy*. Thecomplete abstract volume is also available to all on the Mineralogical Society's website (www.minersoc.org).

While at Cambridge, many groups took the opportunity to attend to some administrative business, including the Mineralogical Society of Great Britain & Ireland (MSGBI) and the Mineralogical Association of Canada (MAC) annual general meetings, as well as a gathering of the Editors and Executive Committee of *Elements*, the magazine for Mineralogists and Geochemists (www.elementsmagazine.org).

Many people contributed to the success of the meeting: the Mineralogical Society staff, the staff at the Department of Earth Sciences, Cambridge, who were unfailingly helpful and courteous, the staff at Fitzwilliam College, but especially those people who helped to organize the scientific sessions which were of top quality in all respects.

So, what's next? There are many meetings. Some would say too many. But I don't suppose we ever tire of good meetings. Frontiers II anyone?
