

SCHOOL MAGAZINES - NATIONAL COLLECTION

The National Library of Australia has requested that we publish the following appeal -

For some years, the Library has been aware that although some schools deposit their magazine in the national collection, the majority do not. The social historians and biographers of the future will, by this gap in the national collection, be deprived of a very significant research resource. The features, early literary efforts and academic and sporting achievements of Australians of national importance are frequently recorded only in school magazines, and although many schools are able, years after the event, to offer the researcher access to a complete back-file, others do not have the space in which to keep one.
