THE COMPARISON OF SEXUAL FUNCTION AND INFERTILITY IN FERTILE AND INFERTILE COUPLES

Introduction: Fertility is an important factor in life which can be disturbed due to several factors.

Aims: The aim of this study was to determine the relationship between infertility and sexual dysfunction.

Methods: In an analytic - descriptive study 384 fertile and 384 infertile referring women to obstetrics and gynecological clinics were studied. All these women were evaluated considering the sexual functions. Finally the results were analyzed statistically.

Results: The age average of these women was 27.84 4.67 and 27.38 5.45 in infertile and fertile groups respectively.

The sexual desire ($P < 0.001$), the sexual arousal ($P < 0.001$). The ability of reach to orgasm ($P < 0.001$) and satisfaction from intercourse was better in fertile women.

Conclusions: It was concluded that the sexual function was significantly better in fertile women.
