In 1967 it was incorporated under the laws of the State of New Jersey as a non-profit corporation. In informal correspondence it is referred to as ASTR.

Theatre Survey, the official journal of the Society, is published twice a year, in May and November. The Annual Meeting of the ASTR occurs each fall.
