Obviously such changes would require alterations to be made in the constitution so that a proposal would need to be put to the A.G.M. in July and changes might not be implemented until 1976. However if the membership were in favour of such changes, as an interim measure the E.C. might use its powers of co-option to include branch representatives into its meetings for the intervening year.

We would welcome some discussion by the membership on the above suggestions.
