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#### **Notes for Contributors**

**Policy** The *Phonology Yearbook* is concerned with all aspects of phonology and related disciplines. Most volumes are partly or wholly devoted to one or more themes, although from time to time particular volumes or parts of volumes will be non-thematic in nature. The editors encourage the submission of papers on proposed themes as well as on other topics relevant to the interests of the *Yearbook*. Non-thematic papers will be considered for publication at all times.

The theme for Volume 4 (1987) is:

Syntactic conditions on phonological rules (Guest editors: Arnold Zwicky & Ellen Kaisse)

Volume 5, which will be published in the second half of 1988, will be non-thematic. Submissions are encouraged on any topic relevant to the interests of the *Yearbook*; they should reach the editors not later than the beginning of September 1987.

The normal language of publication is English. Contributors intending to submit a manuscript in another language should first contact the editors.

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
